

Customer Proprietary Network Information (CPNI)

Federal Communications Commission (FCC) rules govern the use and disclosure of Customer Proprietary Network Information (CPNI). Establishing a password and email address of record for your South Slope Cooperative Communications account will help protect your privacy and prevent identity theft. In order to comply with FCC rules regarding customer call detail and account information, South Slope must verify the identity of the requesting party. When visiting our office you may present a valid picture ID. Over the phone you may verify your identity by providing a pre-established password, or South Slope can contact you directly at your home phone number, or postal or electronic address of record.

Your password will be used to authenticate account information each time you call our office. Establishing an email address gives South Slope the option to communicate with you through the email address you provide. Although it may seem like an inconvenience, these precautions are for your protection. Failure to establish a password will restrict our ability to serve you and may require us to deny you service.

This form will establish a password, back-up question, and electronic address of record for purposes relating to CPNI.
