

ANNUAL MEETING SOUTH SLOPE COMMUNITY CENTER NORTH LIBERTY, IA APRIL 19, 2023

The Annual Meeting of the members of South Slope Cooperative Telephone Company was held in the Community Center at South Slope Cooperative Telephone Co., 980 North Front Street, North Liberty, Iowa on April 19, 2023.

Board of Directors President, Michael Schanz, announced the Cooperative had a quorum present and called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. with all Board members present. Secretary Brian Butz read the notification of the 2023 annual meeting. President Schanz informed those attending that the minutes of the 2022 Annual Meeting were available at the registration tables. Todd Thorson gave a financial review of the Cooperative.

CEO Chuck Deisbeck reviewed the Cooperative operations and the growth of the Cooperative.

Riley Coy read the nominating committee's report. The report was as follows:

The Nominating Committee met on a conference call at 6:00 p.m., March 7, 2023. The following candidate was nominated for re-election to the expiring Fairfax/Swisher term: incumbent, Brian Butz. The following candidate was nominated for re-election to the expiring Norway/Ely term: incumbent, Brad Meskimen. Signed: Randy Walter.

Attorney Riley Coy read the election results. Brian Butz was re-elected to represent Fairfax/Swisher and Brad Meskimen was re-elected to represent Norway/Ely.

President Schanz announced \$500,000 to be used to retire all patronage for the year 1992.
